**WHAT WAS THE DUBLIN ART COLONY?**

From the late 19th to the mid-20th centuries, artists Abbott Thayer, Frank Benson, George de Forest Brush and Mary Brush, Joseph Lindon Smith, William Preston Phelps, Martha Silsbee, Rockwell Kent, Alexander James, Richard Meryman, and others worked in the shadow of Mount Monadnock. Writers including Mark Twain and Amy Lowell also sojourned here. Although this group never referred to itself as an art colony, its participants cultivated a sense of community centered on the arts. Showing in a gallery, I'm flying blind—I don't get any feedback. The Tour lets artists see how people react to our art, and it lets them see how we do it. It's a wonderful and rare opportunity for everyone!"

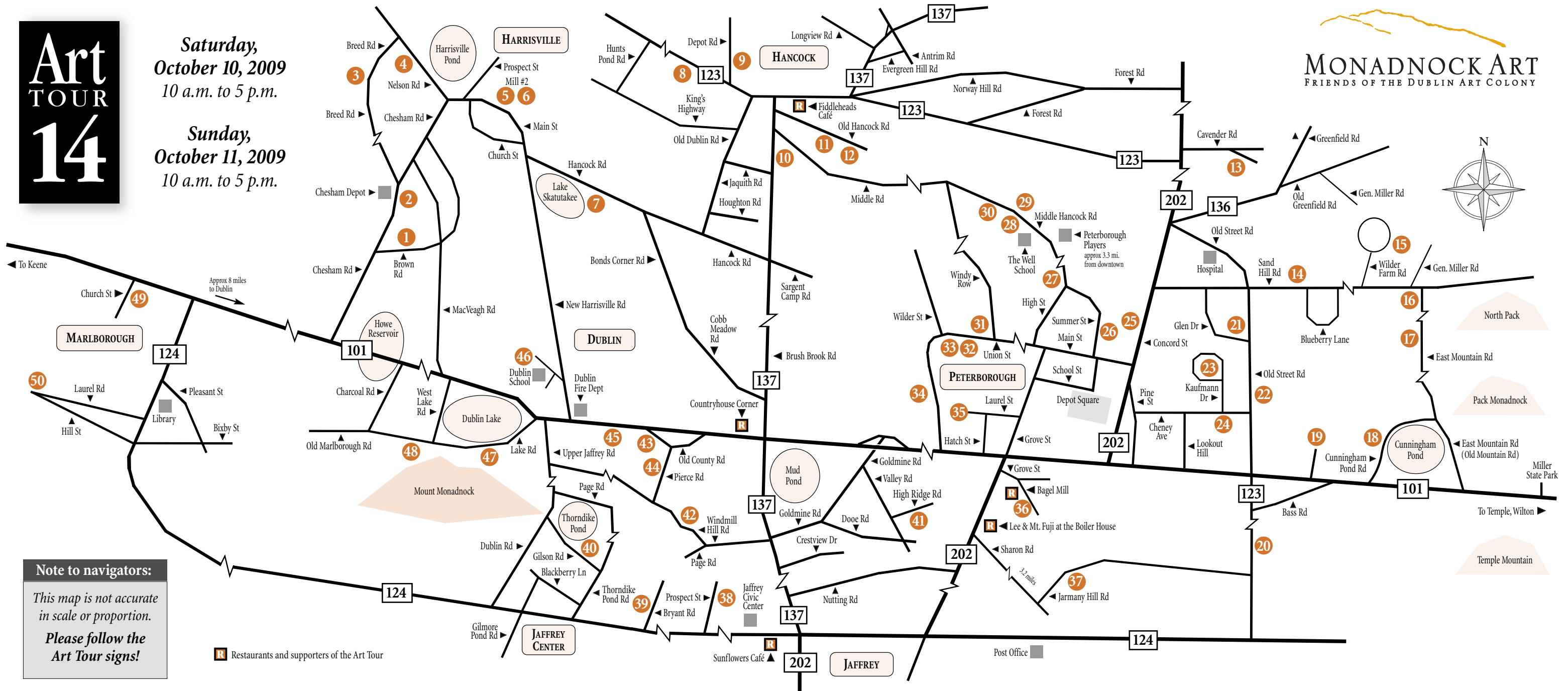
